

Toilet Twinning



Did you know: 2.4 billion people don't have somewhere safe, clean and hygienic to go to the loo? That's more than a third of the people on the planet. They have to use fields, streams, rivers, railway lines, canal banks, roadsides, plastic bags, or squalid disease-breeding buckets.

Toilet Twinning provides people in the poorest communities on the planet with a decent toilet, clean water and all the information they need to stay healthy. It's the key to helping whole communities break free of the poverty trap.

For just £60, you can twin your loo with a latrine halfway around the world, in a country of your choosing. Your smallest room becomes the proud owner of a personalised certificate, complete with a colour photo of its twin and GPS coordinates so you can look up your twin on Google Maps.

Over the summer we're collecting coins in Smarties tubes, to raise money to help twin our church toilets. Please bring along your filled Smarties tubes to Allsorts in September, or Puddle Ducklings or Boost.

Our September Allsorts will be focused on Toilet Twinning, including a cake sale to raise money towards the Toilet Twinning. Please bring along your pennies to buy, or bake some cakes to sell to help support Tear Fund as they work to provide toilets, clean water, sanitation and hygiene education

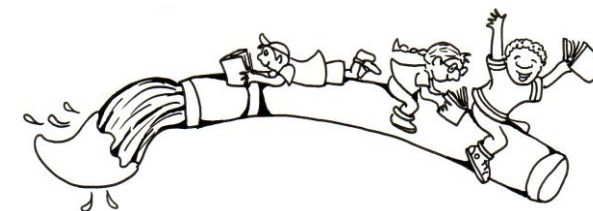
